As mentioned before, the Hong Kong College of Urological Nursing endeavours to run ongoing CNE lecture series for nurses over the years, in addition to the summer Annual Scientific Meeting and the occasional ad hoc themed symposia and workshops. Following the success of seven successive CNE Lecture Series on 'Uro-Radiology', 'Uro-Infection', 'Neuro-Urology and Voiding Dysfunction', 'Prostate Care', 'Uro-oncology & Kidney Tumour', 'Management of Bladder Cancer' and "Prostate Cancer (Part 1)", the College will embark on the eighth series in the near future.
